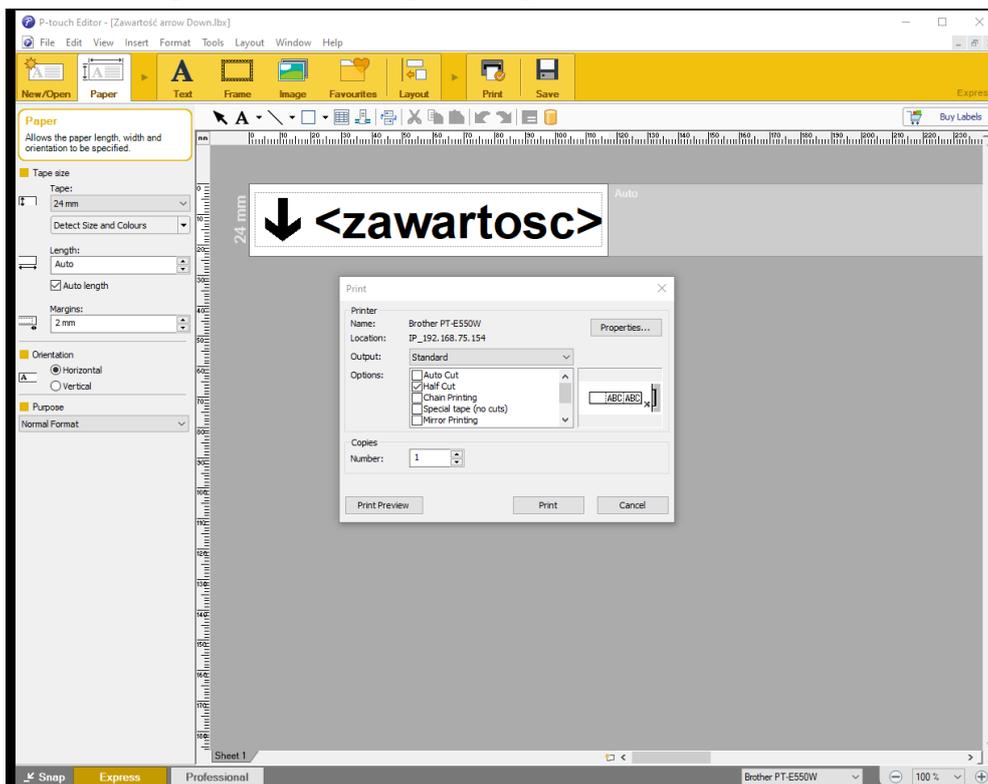


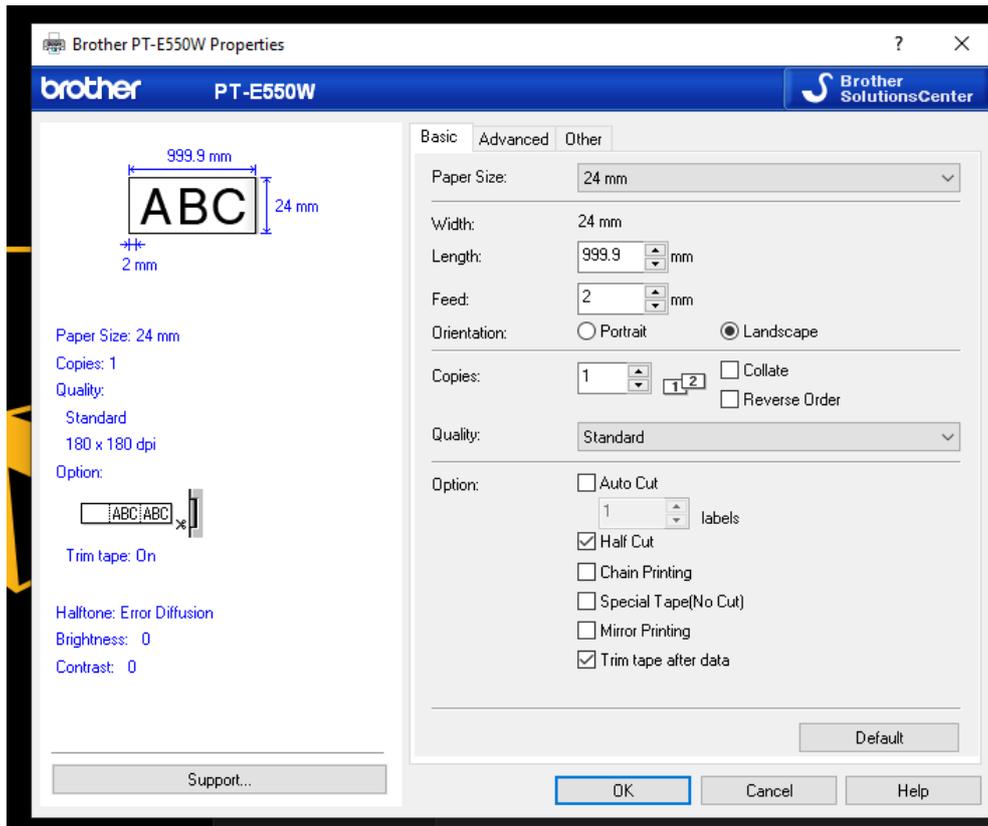
Custom Templates

Brother PT-E550W Label Printer

1. In case of instalment P-touch Editor on a new instance (PC, laptop) follow the instructions below. If using already configured instance – jump to step. 2.
 - 1.1. Download P-touch Editor and drivers on official Brother web-site – [LINK](#).
 - 1.2. After installation open P-touch Editor.
 - 1.3. If you want to store all templates and library files in specific place – go to Tools → Options → Path and re-map the location of your project files, otherwise default values would be used.
 - 1.4. Create label design. Save it.
 - 1.5. Switch on label printer. Make sure WLAN icon is lit on the screen. Otherwise press WiFi button on the keypad.
 - 1.6. Test printing your label from P-touch Editor by clicking Print button.
 - 1.7. In this step connection with the printer should be established. IMPORTANT! Your instance should be connected to the same local network. If not discovered automatically search printer by IP 192.168.75.154.
 - 1.8. Once printer connected go to Properties in the Print window.

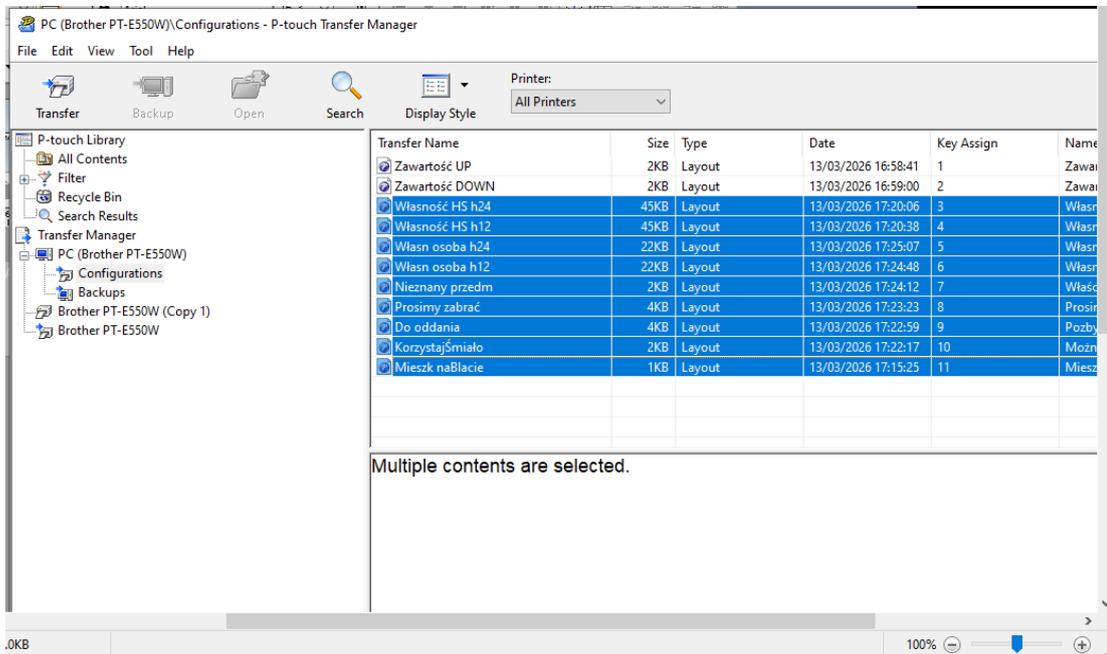


1.9. In the printer Properties window in Option section it is recommended to toggle “Half Cut” and “Trim tape after data”, others leave empty. Click OK.



1.10. Select number of copies and hit Print. Expected result – labels printed, tape is automatically cut off. Otherwise troubleshooting steps needed (not covered in this guide).

2. Connect label printer with USB cable to the instance and launch P-touch Editor. In some cases restart of previously opened application is needed in order for printer to connect properly.
3. Open your label design and go to File → Transfer Template → Transfer.
4. P-touch Transfer Manager should open.



- 4.1. Provide Transfer Name to the template. It has limited character length and will be displayed on the label printer. If provided name matches with the existing in the printer library Transfer Manager will notify you.
- 4.2. Printer should also appear at the bottom of the navigation tree.
- 4.3. **IMPORTANT!** Only templates opened in the P-touch Editor will appear in the Transfer Manager.
5. Hit Transfer button and follow the instructions.
6. Your custom label is now available on Brother PT-E550W Label Printer. Navigation path is  key → Transferred Templates. Required tape size is shown on the screen.
